
Pediatric Nausea / Vomiting & Dehydration

Premature	120-170 [*]	55-75/35-45
0-3 mo	100-150*	65-85/45-55
3-6 mo	90-120	70-90/50-65
6-12 mo	80-120	80-100/55-65
1-3 yr	70-110	90-105/55-70
3-6 yr	65-110	95-110/60-75
6-12 yr	60-95	100-120/60-75
12+yr	55-85	110-135/65-85

^{*}In sleep, infant heart rates may drop significantly lower but if perfusion is maintained no intervention is required

- ¹ Signs and Symptoms of Dehydration/Shock:
- Tachycardia
- Lethargy
- Pale, cool extremities
- Absent tears
- Sunken fontanelle
- Poor skin turgor
- Capillary refill > 2 seconds
- Weak peripheral pulses

normal SBP = 70 + (age in yrs x2)
