## **ETOMIDATE**

**Additional Names: Amidate Classification: General Anesthetic** Hypnotic **Indications:** To induce general anesthesia to facilitate intubation **Contraindications:** Known hypersensitivity Adult: **Dosages:** <u>Delayed/Rapid Sequence Intubation (if approved by agency's Medical Director)</u> 0.3 mg/kg IV/IO **Side Effects:** Transient injection site pain, myoclonic muscle events, adrenal suppression Nonbarbiturate hypotonic that acts on the CNS by stimulating gamma-aminobutyric acid **Physiological: Effects** (GABA) receptors. Has minimal cardiovascular effects. Lacks analgesic activity. **Additional Info:** Muscle spasm is most commonly seen when Etomidate is injected quickly. Airway should be directly observed at all times when this medication is administered.
