## **KETOROLAC (TORADOL)**

Additional Names: Toradol

**Classification:** Dissociative Anesthetic

Indications: Pain Management

moderate to severe pain caused by inflammation such as: Moderate pain from trauma associated with swelling

Sickle Cell

bone cancer patients

**Contraindications:** 

Should not be used in patients with renal concerns.

Dosages: Adult:

<u>Traumatic Pain Management</u> 15-30mg IV or 30-60mg IM

Contact Medical Control if additional analgesia in needed.

**ACS Pain Management** 

15-30mg IV or 30-60mg IM

Non - Traumatic Abdominal Pain Management

15-30mg IV or 30-60mg IM

**Pediatric:** 

<u>Traumatic Pain Management</u> 0.5 mg/kg IV /IO/ IM (max 15 mg)

Additional Information:

Does not affect mental status, respiratory drive, mobility of intestines.

It is an ideal alternative for patients in remission from opioid abuse, patients with hypersensitivity to or reservations about opioid medications, patients

presenting with constipation.
